Keynote Speaker



Dr. Rich Callahan's consulting, teaching, and research focuses on leadership behaviors that are effective in complex, demanding, and dynamic public sector environments. He is a Co-Founder and Principal in the consulting firm of TAP International. At the University of San Francisco, Callahan is a full-time Professor in the Master of Public Health and Master of Public Administration programs. He has worked with elected and appointed officials and nonprofit leaders for the past 25 years.

Dr. Callahan is an elected Fellow in the Congressionally chartered U.S. National Academy of Public Administration. He is current Editor in Chief of the *International Journal of Public Leadership*, a peer reviewed journal, published by Emerald Press, London, UK. He was a visiting researcher at Oxford University, 2016. He was the Visiting Scholar 2017-2018 for the Center for California Studies at California State University, Sacramento.

Dr. Callahan has been published in journals including *The National Civic Review*, *Public Administration Review*, *Public Management Review*, *Public Manager*, *Journal of Public Administration Review and Theory*, *American Review of Public Administration*, *Government Finance Officers Review*, and *Journal of Jesuit Business Education*.

He is a graduate of Georgetown University with a doctorate from the University of Southern California, as well as having trained in judo at Tenri University in Japan.
